



INTRODUCING THE SECU FOUNDATION CHALLENGE

We're excited to launch the SECU Foundation Challenge to raise an additional \$3.9 million for the Campaign. All gifts made to the 50th Anniversary Campaign moving forward will count toward the Challenge until it is complete, allowing TLC to secure \$1.5 million to finish the Residents Village, including the new ICF home.

The new ICF home is expected to open in the spring of 2024, launching the renovations and expansions of the two existing homes (Tucker and Civitan), to complete the Residents Village phase of construction on TLC's main campus in 2025.

OPENING DOORS

Your generous support of TLC made through the Challenge will open doors, quite literally. A funding gap remains and gifts made to the 50th Anniversary Campaign will help close the gap to complete the Residents Village phase. Closing the gap before the new ICF home is completed in spring 2024 will allow for minimal disruption for residents and staff. Currently, renovations of the two existing ICF homes (Tucker and Civitan) are sequentially timed to happen immediately following the construction of the new ICF home. Once these three projects are complete, the Residents Village will be a reality and TLC will kick off the next phase of transformations on our main campus to bring solutions to the growing needs and shortages of services in our community.
