Our Tailored Care Management program provides a dedicated Care Manager to coordinate all aspects of a person's health care and supports — medical, behavioral, long-term, and community services. Our Care Management team works with the client, their family and/or guardians, as well as their doctors, service providers, therapists, and others to coordinate an individualized plan of care, resulting in better wholeperson, family, and community outcomes.
